### Event description

This 1-day Course will focus on long bones fractures, indications for application of External Fixation (ESF), challenges and complications. The lectures will be case based in order to bring you “the real case” scenario. Discussion over case studies will provide you ample opportunity for interaction and questions.

During the labs you will have the opportunity to apply different ESF frames to radius/ ulna and tibia fractures under the supervision and expert guide of the faculty that will share with you their experience with precious hints and tips.

### Learning objectives

- Discuss the bone healing process in an environment of relative stability

- Compare the different biological needs of simple and comminuted fractures
- Recognize the indications for application of different types of ESF frames
- Identify and assemble the different components of ESF
- Perform the technique of pre-drilling and insertion of threaded pins in metaphyseal and diaphyseal bone
- Compare and discuss different techniques for fracture reduction
- Identify most common fracture patterns in radius/ulna and tibia
- Compare the different fixation option according to biological and mechanical factors
- Decision-make on treatment options for Radius/ulna and tibia fractures

- Identify most common complications related to applications of ESF
- Recognize the surgical and post-operative management challenges
